## Guidance for Reusables

The Alameda County Health Department has issued a revised shelter-in-place order that includes stricter measures in regards to using reusable bags, mugs, and other reusable items.

**TRY THIS:** Grocery stores and food establishments encourage your customers to avoid single-use bags by keeping reusable bags in their cars and using shopping carts/baskets to transfer loose purchased items outside the store and into reusable bags.

# Proper Sorting Keeps Garbage out of the Recyclables (and keeps Recyclables out of the landfill!)

**SUPPORT THE SORT!** Please place only recyclable materials directly into your blue **RECYCLABLES** cart or bin. Do not use plastic liner bags. Remember masks and gloves belong in the **GARBAGE**.

**JUST SAY "NO" TO CONTAMINANTS!** **GARBAGE** and **ORGANICS** DO NOT belong in the blue **RECYCLABLES** cart or bin.

**MAINTAIN A CLEAN STREAM!** Empty and rinse recyclable plastic, metal and glass food containers before placing them in the blue **RECYCLABLES** cart or bin.



## Did You Know?

**40% of the material in the recyclables container is paper.**
