Day 1 Friday, June 4, 2021

Depart via scheduled air service to Prague, Czech Republic

Day 2 Saturday, June 5 Prague (D)

Arrive in Prague

Meet your MCI Tour Manager, who will assist the group to awaiting chartered motorcoach

Enjoy a panoramic tour of Prague that includes seeing the Charles Bridge, Old Town Square, the Tyn Church, the Astronomical Clock, and the Jewish Quarter

Lunch, on own

Late afternoon hotel check-in

Evening Welcome Dinner included, and overnight

Prague is one of the most enchanting cities in Europe. It was under Charles IV during the 14th century that Prague briefly became the seat of the Holy Roman Empire (virtually the capital of Western Europe) and acquired its distinctive Gothic imprint. Prague escaped serious wartime damage and is considered one of the most beautiful cities in Europe today. Mozart claimed that no one understood him better than the citizens of Prague, and he was only one of several great masters who lived or lingered here

Day 3 Sunday, June 6 Prague (B,D)

Breakfast included at the hotel

Enjoy a guided tour of Prague. Visit the Castle District, where entrance is included to Hradcany Castle, St. Vitus Cathedral, the Old Royal Palace, the Golden Lane, and Daliborka Tower. Also visit Lobkowitz Palace with its large music archive containing works by over five hundred composers and musicians. The Music Archive is most celebrated for its collection of works by Handel, Mozart, Haydn and Beethoven

Afternoon at leisure for shopping and sightseeing

Performance in Prague as part of the Beethoven 250 Concert Series*

Evening dinner included, and overnight

Day 4 Monday, June 7 Vienna (B,D)

Breakfast included at the hotel, followed by check-out

Morning transfer to Vienna

Lunch, on own

Enjoy a visit to the Vienna City Cemetery to visit the graves of Beethoven, Strauss, Brahms, Schubert and the Mozart Memorial

Next, enjoy a panoramic tour of Vienna's highlights

Day 5 Tuesday, June 8 Vienna (B,D)

Half-day guided tour of *Historical Vienna* includes the Ringstraße, Imperial Palace, State Opera, Town Hall, Burgkapelle (home of the Vienna Boys Choir), Palace Stables, Strauß Monument, and entrance to Schönbrunn Palace, built by the Hapsburgs in imitation of Versailles

Day 6 Wednesday, June 9 Vienna (B,D)

Breakfast included at the hotel

Half-day guided tour of *Musical Vienna* includes entrance to the Haus der Musik (House of Music), a modern interactive sound museum located in the historic city center. This tour also includes the Museum of the Vienna Philharmonic, which is part of the House of Music

Overnight at the hotel

Day 7 Thursday, June 10 Vienna (B,D)

Breakfast included at the hotel

Morning visit to the Kahlenberg located in the Vienna Woods to see the Beethoven trail. Also visit (entrance included) the Beethoven Heiligenstadt apartment (where Beethoven's Testament was written and is kept)

Lunch, on own

Afternoon at leisure

Evening Beethoven Choral Festival Concert in St. Stephen's Cathedral*

Evening dinner included, and overnight

Day 8 Friday, June 11 Salzburg (B,D)

Breakfast included at the hotel, followed by check-out

Transfer to Salzburg

Enjoy a guided tour of Salzburg including Mirabell Palace and Gardens, Mozart Square, the Dom (cathedral), University Church, entrance to the Mozarthaus (Mozart's birthplace) and a cable car ride up to the Fortress (for an unparalleled view of the city below)

Performance in Salzburg as part of the Beethoven 250 Concert Series*

Evening dinner included, and overnight

Salzburg, Mozart's birthplace, is a delight from the first sight of the outline of the Hohensalzburg Fortress, the symbol of the power of the prince-archbishops. The city's picturesque streets with their wrought-iron signs, its spacious squares with sculptured fountains and the noble architecture of its buildings inspired by bishops with a passion for construction, leave memories which linger for years

Day 9 Saturday, June 12 Salzburg/Neuschwanstein/ Munich (B,D)

Breakfast included at the hotel, followed by check-out

Morning tour of Salzburg. Sightseeing today will include driving past Schloß Leopoldskron, featured in "The Sound of Music" and entrance to Schloß Hellbrunn with its famous "Sound of Music" gazebo and trick fountains

Lunch, on own

Transfer to Munich via Neuschwanstein Castle

Neuschwanstein Castle (made famous by the Walt Disney model in Anaheim), built by the infamous Ludwig II (including entrance and uphill transport). Also visit the charming Wieskirche (Church in the Meadow) and Oberammergau, the site of the world famous Passion Play which is performed every 10 years

Continue on to Munich

Evening Farewell Dinner included, and overnight

Munich is ideally located in southern Germany near the Alps. It is a first-class cultural center and is a flourishing economic zone. Munich's cultural wealth, its special atmosphere - a blend of gaiety, tolerance and respect for tradition - and the beauty of the surrounding countryside have combined to make it one of the most appreciated of German cities

Day 10 Sunday, June 13 Depart for home (B)

Breakfast included at the hotel, followed by check-out

Transfer to the Munich Airport for return flight home
