Rather, we must focus on defining opportunities that celebrate our strengths and successes in delivering valuable programs to the residents of the Greater Des Moines area.

The key point to building relationships with our neighbors is to improve community connection. Through connection, we establish dialogue, identify trends and understand the context for making progressive changes in our communities. Context establishes the cause of a problem that needs addressing, accountability (i.e. who is best positioned to implement change), and can help identify a system to move forward to mutual success.
