



State Park Speedway Eve of Devastation September 26, 2020 Rules

Registration

1. Pit gate and registration the day of the event will open at 12:00pm and end at 2:00pm.
2. Anyone entering the pits must buy a \$25 pit pass and sign the insurance forms.
3. Driver must attend the drivers' meeting.
4. Free Camping

Cars & Safety

1. Uni-body Cars, minivans and compact pick-ups allowed. No Convertables. **(Full frame cars and Full size trucks, will be allowed to participate in the Trailer Race only)**
2. All cars must have factory seat belt with shoulder and lap belt in good working condition (4-point or better safety harnesses highly recommended and must use a shoulder belt bar welded into the vehicle).
3. Helmets are mandatory for every event, with visor or goggles. **** (SA2010 label or better on all helmets)****.
4. Long pants, long sleeves, and gloves are mandatory (fire suit highly recommended).
5. No open toes shoes or sandals allowed in pit area.
6. Cars must be safe for the road or better (properly installed roll cage highly recommended).
 - A. Car must have OEM doors.
 - B. **All doors** MUST be chained, welded or otherwise fixed shut.
 - C. Do not gut your car excessively – it is a SAFETY issue.
 - D. Street tires only, with **all wheel weights and hubcaps removed**.
7. Fire extinguisher securely mounted within drivers reach highly recommended.
8. If the gas tank is behind the rear axle it must be moved from the stock position. A fuel cell needs to be installed behind the driver's seat, covered and mounted to the floorboards.
9. Window nets are recommended.
10. One vertical support bar or tow strap installed behind the driver's seat to prevent the seat from collapsing is recommended.
11. **All mirrors and glass** except the windshield must be removed. If the windshield is removed it must be replaced with Lexan and supports or 1/4" steel mesh and supports.
12. Glass in a sunroof must be removed and the roof covered with metal.
13. **No anti-freeze**. Remove anti-freeze prior to coming to the track and fill radiator with water. If you are caught on the track with coolant in your car you will be fined \$150.
14. All cars must have a number painted on them at least 18" high.
15. All cars will be inspected by track officials before the start of the event.
