A special meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro Tem, Amber Nickelson, on September 18, 2017, at 5:30 p.m. at the Monroe City Hall. The purpose of the meeting was to conduct interviews for the Monroe Police Department.

Roll call was taken. Members in attendance were: Mayor Pro Tem, Amber Nickelson, Jeff Hegwood, Alicia Hansen, Jean Goemaat, Nate Bradbury, Police Chief, Nicholas Chambers, and City Clerk, Kim Thomas. There were no visitors at the meeting. Mayor Doug Duinink was absent from the meeting.

Council Member Goemaat moved and was seconded by Council Member Bradbury to enter into closed session at 5:33 p.m. under Iowa Code 21.5 (i) to conduct interviews for the Monroe Police Officer Position. Motion carried 5-0.

At 6:04 p.m. a motion by Goemaat was made to exit closed session. Council Member Hegwood seconded the request. Motion carried 5-0.

The council agreed to discuss the replacement of the Monroe Library playground slide at the October regular meeting. Bradbury was going to discuss the slide replacement with the Kiwanis Board on the 19th of September. Council Member Hansen asked about the status of the turning light on the explorer and if it had been fixed yet along with inquiring about shift changes for the police department. Chief Chambers stated that the part for the explorer had been ordered and he was waiting to hear back from Ulrich's.

Bradbury moved and was seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Nickelson to adjourn at 6:12 p.m. Motion carried 5-0.
