A special meeting of the Monroe City Council was called to order by Mayor Briles on September 3, 2014 at 6:35 p.m. the Monroe City Hall. Kim Thomas, City Clerk; Matt Mardesen, City Administrator; Nicholas Chambers, newly appointed Police Chief; and Wes Breckenridge were in attendance.
