How to experience the Panama Canal:

Historic Locks: On Coral Princess® and Island Princess® you'll transit the Panama Canal via the Gatun, Miraflores and Pedro Miguel Locks on a Panama Canal Ocean to Ocean voyage or the Miraflores and Pedro Miguel Locks on the Panama Canal Pacific Adventure voyage. Sailing from either Ft. Lauderdale or Los Angeles, you'll experience one of mankind's greatest engineering achievements as each historic lock fills with an astonishing 52 million gallons of water powered purely by gravity.

New Locks: Discover the new Agua Clara Locks on a 10-day Panama Canal with Costa Rica and Caribbean sailing, where you'll enjoy scenic cruising in Gatun Lake before returning back through the locks on Crown Princess® or Emerald Princess®. Or on a 15-day Panama Canal Ocean to Ocean aboard Emerald Princess®, you'll experience both the new Cocoli Locks and the Agua Clara Locks while transiting the 48-mile canal.
