During the month of January OLGC parish as well as many parishes throughout our city and the nation, **displays White Crosses on the grounds** nearby the Church Driveway entrance. These white crosses represent a silent memorial for the unborn babies, a *Cemetery of the Innocents*. We mourn these babies. We pray that this memorial will help save unborn babies by touching the hearts of the undecided and confronting those who favor abortion.

The **14th Annual "March for Life St Augustine" (MFLSA)** is Saturday, **January 18**, at the Shrine of Our Lady of La Leche (101 San Marco Ave). The message this year is *Endangered, Worthy of Protection*, which focuses on the worthiness of all human life to be protected, especially those with special needs.

MFLSA **Friday Night Kick-off January 17** which begins at 5:30 pm with Rosary followed by Mass at 6:00 pm. The movie *Restored* will be shown. Food trucks and praise and worship concert begin at 7:30 pm at the mission grounds.
