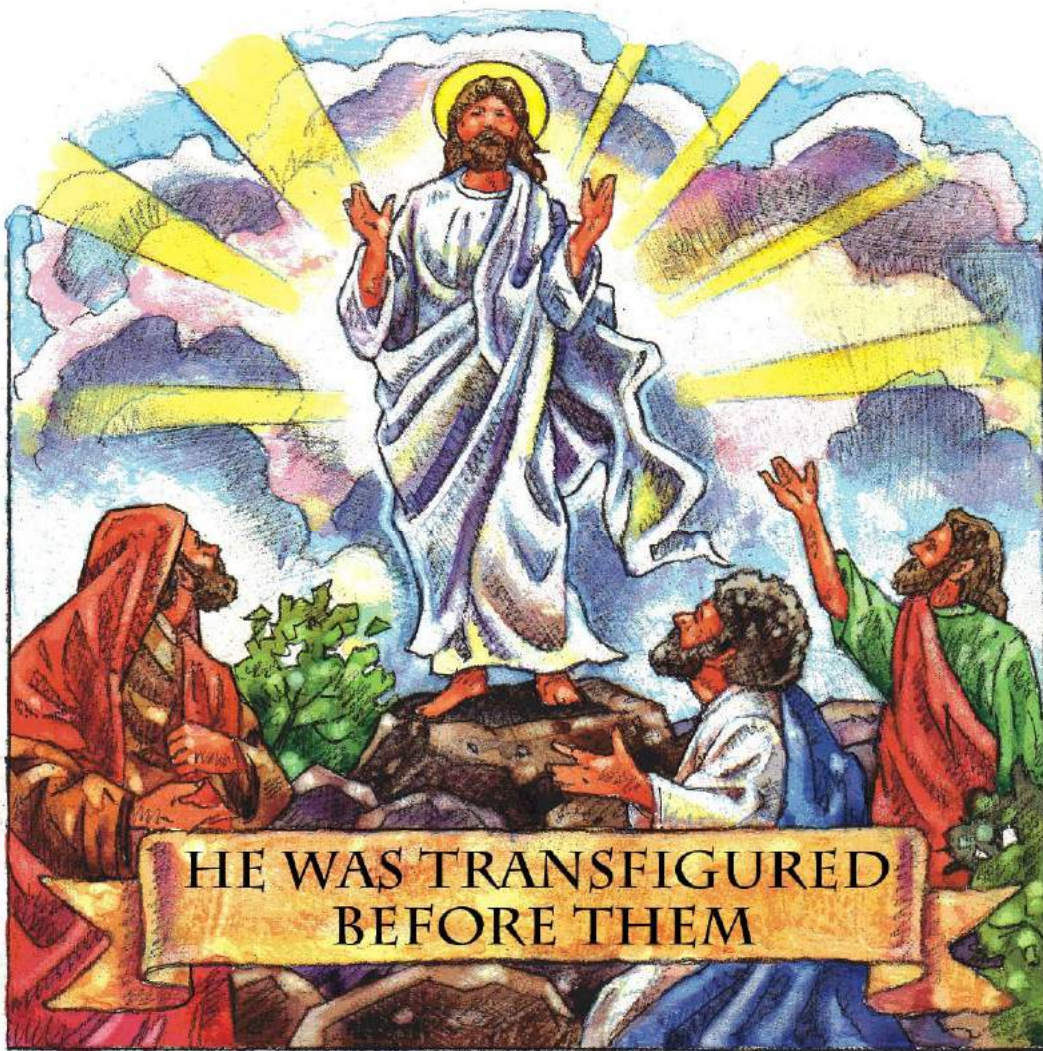

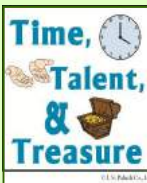

**Requirement for Volunteers "Protecting God's Children":** All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact OLG Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called "Protecting God's Children" ("PGC"). A diocesan volunteer application must be submitted to OLG Parish Office. Please call the Parish Office if you have any questions. **No persons ministering with minor children or vulnerable adults may do so unless they have fully completed all requirements (Diocesan policy per Bishop Estévez).**

**Baptism:** Preparation must be made in advance and Baptismal Class for the parents is required for those wishing to have their children baptized. **Baptismal Class is to be arranged with Pastor, Rev. Guy Francis Noonan, call 904-824-8688 for appointment.**

**All Sponsors:** Sponsors for all Sacraments must be active Catholics. Anyone asking to receive a document from the parish to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation in another parish must be an active Catholic at OLG. This implies regular Mass attendance and participation in the support of the community.
