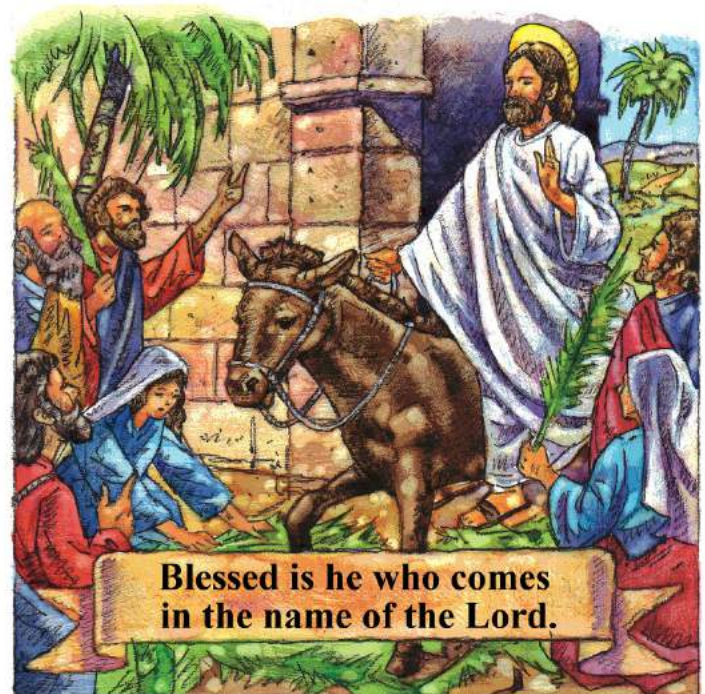


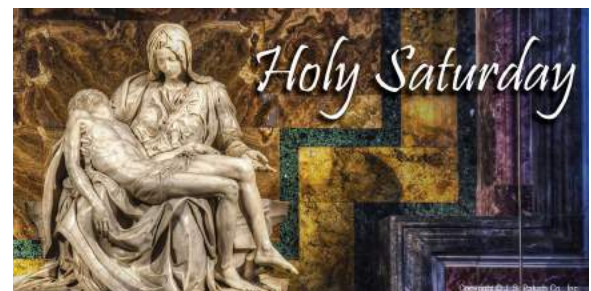

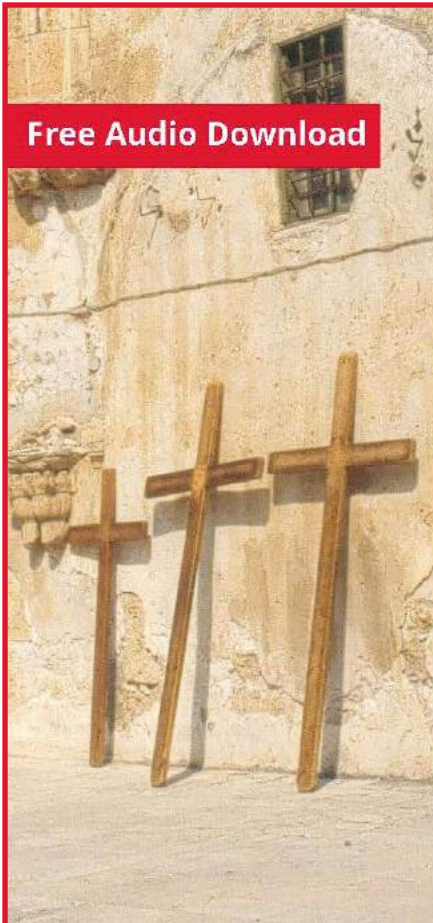

From the Office of the Bishop, March 23, 2020

Recap of suspensions and dispensations in effect:

Suspension of Sunday and Weekday Mass:

All public Masses are suspended in the churches and chapels of the Diocese of St. Augustine **until further notice** (i.e., no weekday or Sunday public Masses, no communion services, or Masses in homes).

Priests will still offer the Sacrifice of the Mass daily (but without participation by the faithful) for the needs of the Church and the world, especially as we face the present realities of the pandemic.

Dispensation from Sunday Mass:

By his authority as the diocesan bishop to dispense from universal ecclesiastical laws, Bishop Estévez has indefinitely dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass three categories of people for as long as the specific condition below continues:

All who are sick and those who are caring for them

Those who because of age or infirmity are at higher risk for contracting the coronavirus

Those who have been exposed to the coronavirus because of travel or other circumstances

And to further protect public health and calm fears, Bishop Estévez has also dispensed all the Catholic faithful from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass **until the suspension of Mass is rescinded.**

Dispensation from Lenten obligation to abstain from meat on Fridays:

By his authority as the diocesan bishop to dispense from universal ecclesiastical laws, Bishop Estévez has dispensed all Catholics from the prohibition during Lent this 2020 year to abstain from meat on Fridays.

When families and individuals take advantage of this dispensation, they are asked to consider other acts of penance or charity that they might carry out in its place.

Thank you to all who have committed to support the mission of our Church through the **2020 Bishop's Annual Stewardship Appeal**. Due to the current health crisis the processing of your generous gifts and pledges received through the mail and/or your parish, has been significantly slowed. Gifts that were set up through online giving will continue, without interruption. Additional method of making your offering to OLGC Parish:



Another way to make your offering to the parish is to use "bill pay" through your bank. This method is currently being used by more parishioners. You can make it an automatic transaction with your bank to send your offering through "bill pay" either weekly or monthly. By using this method of payment, your offering will be received automatically, even if you are on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

Make a Gift Through an IRA Charitable Rollover

A distribution from your IRA is a great way to support the Church! If you reached the age of 70½ in 2019, you may make a direct distribution (up to \$100,000) from your IRA to a qualified charity, such as Our Lady of Good Counsel. A qualified direct distribution to our parish from your IRA is not subject to income tax. New Parishioners: Welcome! Please take a few minutes to complete a "Parish Registration & Census" form that may be found in the Church Entrance Area. The data provided by you on this form is kept confidential. When completed, please give to an Usher, mail to the Parish Office or place in the collection basket.

Mass Intentions: If you would like to have a Mass said for a special intention, please pick up the "Mass Intention Request Form" (printed on purple paper) found in the Church Entrance Area in the wooden wall display and drop it into the collection basket or mail it to the Parish Office. The envelope is labeled "Mass Intentions". Please complete all requested information and note the instructions on the form. Suggested offering (Mass Stipend) is \$10.00, **make check payable to OLG Church.**

Requirement for Volunteers "Protecting God's Children": All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact OLG Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called "Protecting God's Children" ("PGC"). Please provide a copy of your completed "PGC" certificate to our Parish Office. Classes can be found online at www.virtus.org. A diocesan volunteer application must be submitted to OLG Parish Office.
