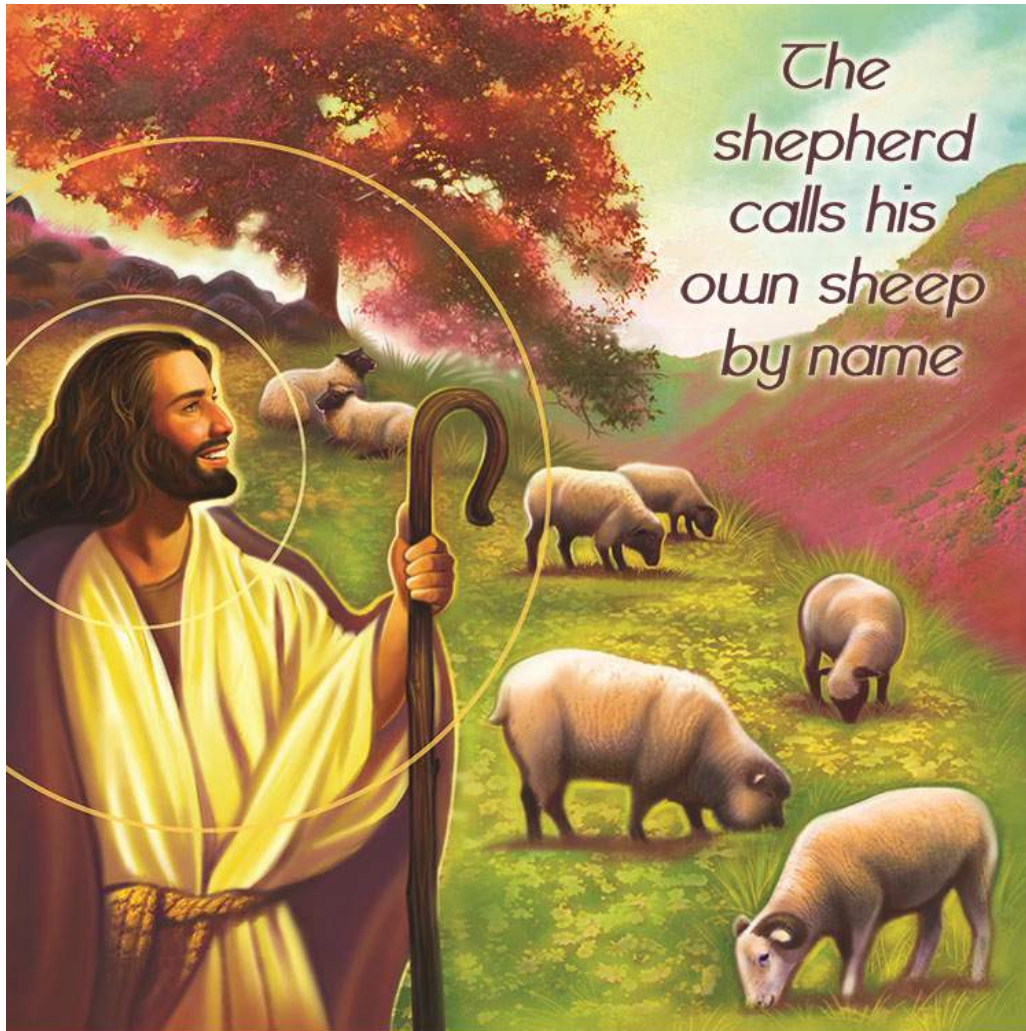

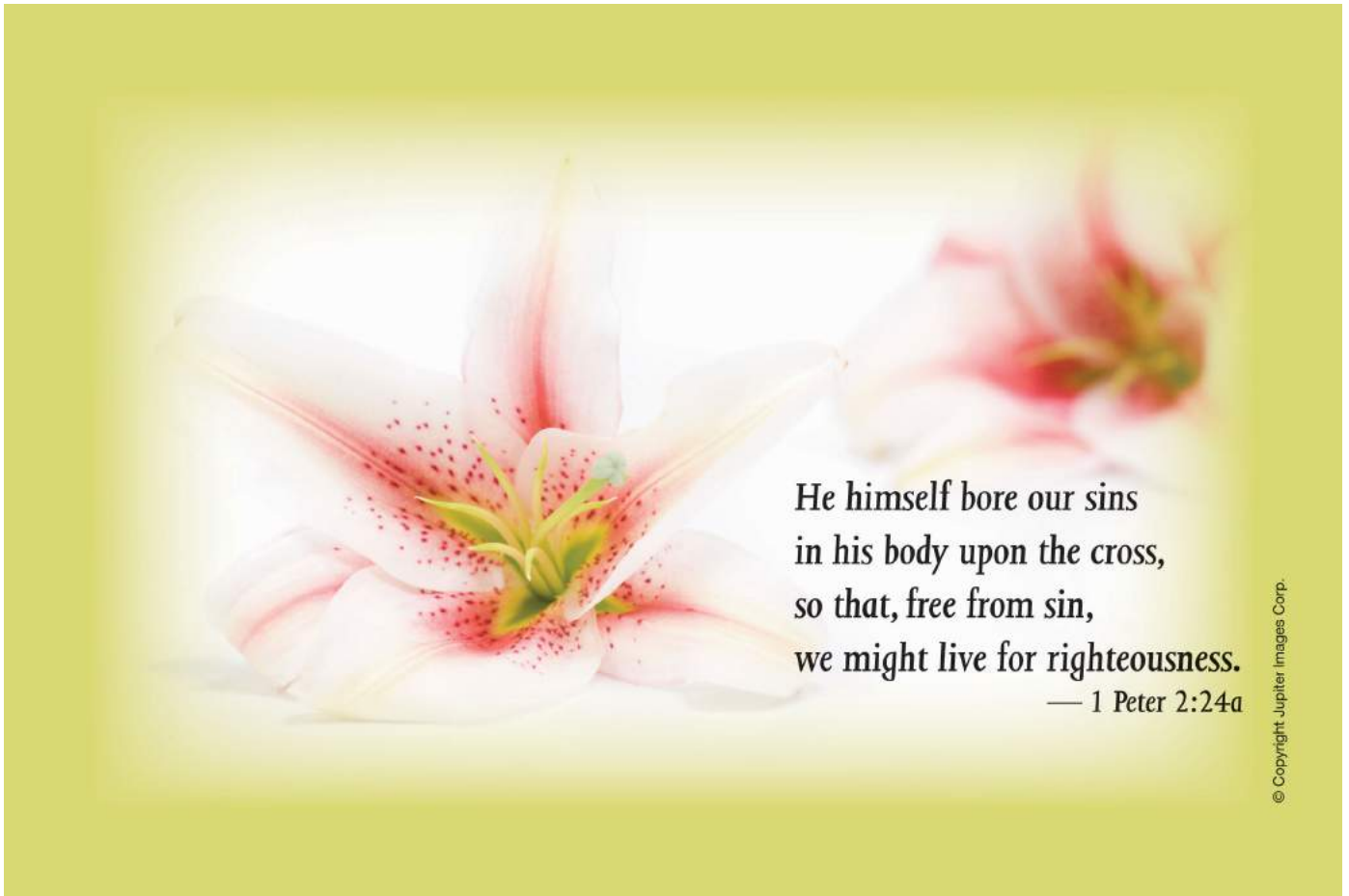

Another way to make your offering to the parish is to use "bill pay" through your bank. This method is currently being used by more parishioners. You can make it an automatic transaction with your bank to send your offering through "bill pay" either weekly or monthly. By using this method of payment, your offering will be received automatically, even if you are on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

Make a Gift Through an IRA Charitable Rollover
 A distribution from your IRA is a great way to support the Church! If you reached the age of 70½ in 2019, you may make a direct distribution (up to \$100,000) from your IRA to a qualified charity, such as Our Lady of Good Counsel. A qualified direct distribution to our parish from your IRA is not subject to income tax. Notice as of April 6, 2020:
 OLGC Parishioner Financial Stewardship notice due to COVID-19, Coronavirus, and the temporary closing of the church:

Obviously, over the past few weeks, Mass attendance has been reduced to zero, and use of envelopes have been seriously diminished. In order to give you a good indicator of financial stewardship participation, we will try to take a look at total monies in and divide by the number of weeks represented. **EXAMPLE:** if we were to have received to date \$14,000 (example only) this must be divided by the number of weeks covered. Thus, for example, two weeks would equal a collection of \$7,000/week which would imply a budget (\$12,000+per week) loss per week of \$5,000 or more. We will keep you informed and get more accurate figures out there but it will take a bit of time.

New Parishioners: Welcome! Please take a few minutes to complete a "Parish Registration & Census" form that may be found in the Church Entrance Area. The data provided by you on this form is kept confidential. When completed, please give to an Usher, mail to the Parish Office or place in the collection basket.

Mass Intentions: If you would like to have a Mass said for a special intention, please pick up the "Mass Intention Request Form" (printed on purple paper) found in the Church Entrance Area in the wooden wall display and drop it into the collection basket or mail it to the Parish Office. The envelope is labeled "Mass Intentions". Please complete all requested information and note the instructions on the form. Suggested offering (Mass Stipend) is \$10.00, **make check payable to OLG Church.**

Prayer Intentions: To add or update a name to OLG's Prayer List, please contact Anton J. Anderle 904-484-6428 marineman150@bellsouth.net

Requirement for Volunteers "Protecting God's Children": All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact OLG Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called "Protecting God's Children" ("PGC"). Please provide a copy of your completed "PGC" certificate to our Parish Office. Classes can be found online at www.virtus.org. A diocesan volunteer application must be submitted to OLG Parish Office. Please call the Parish Office if you have any questions. **No persons ministering with minor children or vulnerable adults may do so unless they have fully completed all requirements (Diocesan policy per Bishop Estévez).**

Baptism: Preparation must be made in advance and Baptismal Class for the parents is required for those wishing to have their children baptized. **Baptismal Class is to be arranged with Pastor, Rev. Guy Francis Noonan, call 904-824-8688 for appointment.**

All Sponsors: Sponsors for all Sacraments must be active Catholics. Anyone asking to receive a document from the parish to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation in another parish must be an active Catholic at OLG. This implies regular Mass attendance and participation in the support of the community.

Preparation for the sacrament includes attending a diocesan program such as Engaged Encounter or Pre Cana, and completing the FOCCUS Inventory. All couples of child-bearing age also need to take a full Natural Family Planning course. Pre-registration for each of these programs is mandatory for all marriages within the Diocese of St Augustine.
