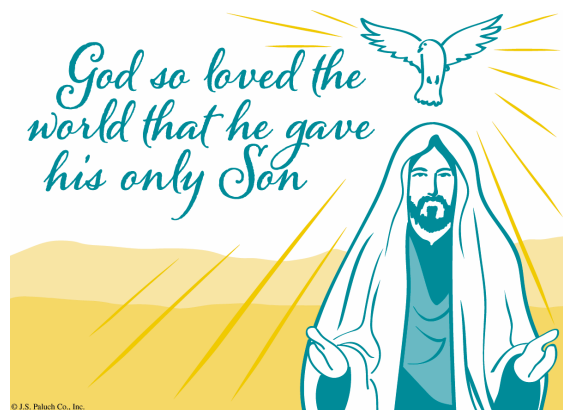

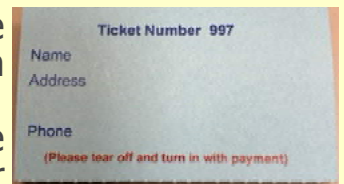
The OLGc **Parish Office** is OPEN from 9 am to 4 pm on Mondays through Thursdays with some Friday hours (please phone before coming in on Friday).

D-Day (June 6th). D - Day is observed on June 6th to honor the 160,000 Allied troops who landed on the beaches of Normandy, France (June 6, 1944): 5,000 ships and 13,000 aircraft supported the D-Day invasion. More than 9,000 Allied Soldiers were killed or wounded. Their sacrifice allowed more than 100,000 Soldiers to begin the slow, hard march across Europe to defeat Germany and end WW II in 1945.

From the U.S. Census Bureau



The 2020 Census is Currently Underway – It's Not Too Late to Respond

In March, the [U.S. Census Bureau](https://www.census.gov) mailed official notices to every household requesting participation in the 2020 Census. With an online option for the first time, as well as mail and phone options, the survey has never been easier. It only takes a few minutes to complete.

There is still time to respond. **The self-response phase has been extended to October 31.** Your prompt response will not only help ensure vital support to neighborhoods across Florida, but it will also protect public health and safety during this COVID-19 pandemic by minimizing the need for census takers to visit homes of those that have not responded.

Census data helps direct federal funds to local communities for education, roads, and other public services. It is also used for planning by hospitals, nursing homes, community centers, churches, schools, and police and fire rescue. A complete and accurate count provides for the common good and well-being of all U.S. residents.

Make a Gift Through an IRA Charitable Rollover

A distribution from your IRA is a great way to support the Church! If you reached the age of 70½, you may make a direct distribution (up to \$100,000) from your IRA to a qualified charity, such as Our Lady of Good Counsel. A qualified direct distribution to our parish from your IRA is not subject to income tax. New Parishioners: Welcome! Please take a few minutes to complete a "Parish Registration & Census" form that may be found in the Church Entrance Area. The data provided by you on this form is kept confidential. When completed, please give to an Usher, mail to the Parish Office or place in the collection basket.

Mass Intentions: If you would like to have a Mass said for a special intention, please pick up the "Mass Intention Request Form" (printed on purple paper) found in the Church Entrance Area in the wooden wall display and drop it into the collection basket or mail it to the Parish Office. The envelope is labeled "Mass Intentions". Please complete all requested information and note the instructions on the form. Suggested offering (Mass Stipend) is \$10.00, **make check payable to OLG Church.**

Prayer Intentions: To add or update a name to OLG's Prayer List, please contact Anton J. Anderle 904-484-6428 marineman150@bellsouth.net

Requirement for Volunteers "Protecting God's Children": All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact OLG Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called "Protecting God's Children" ("PGC"). All Sponsors: Sponsors for all Sacraments must be active Catholics. Anyone asking to receive a document from the parish to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation in another parish must be an active Catholic at OLG.
