The Bishop has allowed the re-opening of public Holy Masses with restrictions.

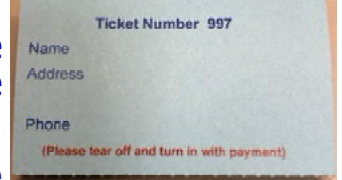
With the Florida Governor's executive order to begin openings inside buildings up to 50% capacity there are still no OLGc group gatherings (6 feet between households).

St. Mark Mission was officially established by Bishop Felipe Estévez on April 25, 2020. The clergy of San Juan del Rio Parish will serve the faith community of the mission. The mission is celebrating Mass on Sundays at 11 am, at the Patriot Oaks Academy school auditorium, located at 475 Longleaf Pine Parkway, in St. Johns 32259 until a church can be built.

St. Mark was formed in response to the rapid growth in northwestern St. Johns County. It was originally named *St. Thérèse of the Child Jesus* because the faithful were meeting in the childcare center of that name located on CR 210. Weekly Mass began there on Feb. 20, 2018. U. S. Army Birthday (June 14th). The United States Army can trace its roots back to 1775. This is when the Continental Congress authorized enlistment of riflemen to serve the United Colonies for one year. The **First Continental Army** (the American Continental Army) was established on June 14, 1775. The Army was created to develop professionally trained soldiers to combat the British Army versus the colonial militias who had carried the fight. On June 15, 1775 Congress unanimously chose George Washington as General and Commander in Chief of the Continental Army.

The 2020 Census is Currently Underway – It's Not Too Late to Respond

In March, the [U.S. Census Bureau](https://www.census.gov) mailed official notices to every household requesting participation in the 2020 Census. With an online option for the first time, as well as mail and phone options, the survey has never been easier. It only takes a few minutes to complete.

There is still time to respond. **The self-response phase has been extended to October 31.** Your prompt response will not only help ensure vital support to neighborhoods across Florida, but it will also protect public health and safety during this COVID-19 pandemic by minimizing the need for census takers to visit homes of those that have not responded.

Census data helps direct federal funds to local communities for education, roads, and other public services. It is also used for planning by hospitals, nursing homes, community centers, churches, schools, and police and fire rescue. A complete and accurate count provides for the common good and well-being of all U.S. residents.

Make a Gift Through an IRA Charitable Rollover

A distribution from your IRA is a great way to support the Church! If you reached the age of 70½, you may make a direct distribution (up to \$100,000) from your IRA to a qualified charity, such as Our Lady of Good Counsel. A qualified direct distribution to our parish from your IRA is not subject to income tax. (For more information about how you and our church can benefit from an IRA charitable rollover, contact your IRA administrator, tax preparer, or the parish office for more information.)

New Parishioners: Welcome! Please take a few minutes to complete a "Parish Registration & Census" form that may be found in the Church Entrance Area. The data provided by you on this form is kept confidential. When completed, please give to an Usher, mail to the Parish Office or place in the collection basket.

Mass Intentions: If you would like to have a Mass said for a special intention, please pick up the "Mass Intention Request Form" (printed on purple paper) found in the Church Entrance Area in the wooden wall display and drop it into the collection basket or mail it to the Parish Office. The envelope is labeled "Mass Intentions". Please complete all requested information and note the instructions on the form. Suggested offering (Mass Stipend) is \$10.00, **make check payable to OLG Church.**

Requirement for Volunteers "Protecting God's Children": All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact OLG Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called "Protecting God's Children" ("PGC"). Please provide a copy of your completed "PGC" certificate to our Parish Office. Classes can be found online at www.virtus.org. A diocesan volunteer application must be submitted to OLG Parish Office. Please call the Parish Office if you have any questions. **No persons ministering with minor children or vulnerable adults may do so unless they have fully completed all requirements (Diocesan policy per Bishop Estévez).**
