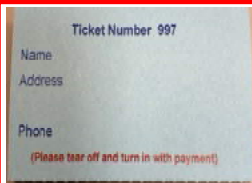
Note for all OLGc Ministries, Committees and Groups:

WEEKLY EVENTS CALENDAR

Due to health concerns for everyone because of the increase of COVID-19: Coronavirus, the OLGc Parish Office is open 9 am to 4 pm Monday through Thursday with some Friday hours (please phone before coming in on Friday).

Visitors inside the office need to wear a mask (required) and social distancing is requested.

The Bishop has allowed the re-opening of public Holy Masses with restrictions.

With the Florida Governor's executive order to allow openings inside buildings with restrictions there are now very limited OLGc group gatherings (6 feet between households).

Requirement for Volunteers "Protecting God's Children": All volunteers over the age of 18 working with minor children or vulnerable adults must be fingerprinted and background check through the Diocese (this is done on a national level and is to be renewed every 5 years). Please contact OLG Parish Office for registration instructions. These volunteers must also attend a class called "Protecting God's Children" ("PGC"). Please provide a copy of your completed "PGC" certificate to our Parish Office. Classes can be found online at www.virtus.org. A diocesan volunteer application must be submitted to OLG Parish Office. Please call Susan M. Waud in the Parish Office if you have any questions. **No persons ministering with minor children or vulnerable adults may do so unless they have fully completed all requirements (Diocesan policy per Bishop Estévez).**

Baptism: Preparation must be made in advance and Baptismal Class for the parents is required for those wishing to have their children baptized. **Baptismal Class is to be arranged with Pastor, Rev. Guy Francis Noonan, call 904-824-8688 for appointment.**

All Sponsors: Sponsors for all Sacraments must be **active** Catholics. Anyone asking to receive a document from the parish to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation in another parish must be an **active** Catholic at OLG. This implies regular Mass attendance and participation in the support of the community.
