

Visitation Guidelines for Outdoor Table Seating

- Visitation will be reservation only to ensure safety and staffing.
 - o At this time, we would like to make reservations for both window visits and outdoor table visits to ensure the best coordination. The following are guidelines for Outdoor Table Visits.
 - o To make a reservation, you must contact **Kamila** and receive confirmation of the reservation. This can be done either by

- Visiting hours will be reserved between the hours of 9:30am – 11:45am and 1pm to 4:45pm, Monday through Sunday*.
- Visits are limited to 45 minutes in duration to allow for transportation to the location as well as proper disinfecting in between visits.*
- We are allowing (1) ONE resident at a time to be visited by maximum (3) THREE adults*
 - o Children under the age of 12 are not counted in the (3) THREE adults limitation. However, it is the family's responsibility to ensure that all children cooperate and remain in the "safe zone".
 - o Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by at least (1) ONE adult.
- Because of the limited area, the maximum number of visits allowed per resident per day is (1) ONE. *
- With the limited amount of visitation reservations available, the facility reserves the right to deny frequent visit requests to allow for fair distribution of visits for all the residents.
- While the outdoor table area is covered with an ample sized umbrella, staff are permitted to reschedule the reservation based on weather.
- **Visitors are asked to arrive early and call the facility (631) 368-9528 prior to arrival in order to complete the following:**
 - o A health-screening form which includes having temperature taken.
 - o A sign-in sheet which includes stating your name, address, phone number, and if possible, email address.
 - o Each individual visitor will have to fill out the forms and be done with every visit, regardless of frequency.
- Visitors and residents will be seated on opposite sides of a 6ft table, with barriers put in place to ensure proper social distancing during the entire time of the visit.
 - o Visitors and residents are not permitted to leave their designated spaces under any circumstance.
 - o **There is NO PERSONAL CONTACT WITH RESIDENTS of any kind.**
- Visitors and residents must wear masks/proper face covering during the entire time of the visitation.
 - o If a visitor does not have a proper face covering, it will be provided for you. However, with limited Personal Protective Equipment, please try to remember to bring your own.
- While staff are able to monitor the area from various vantage points, we may miss a need for assistance. Please do not hesitate to call the facility (631) 368-9528 for any additional assistance needed.
 - o Please do not attempt to resolve an issue yourself, which may lead to breaking the social distance and face mask requirements. We are happy to assist at any time.
- Any visitor who fails to follow these protocols will be prohibited from visitation for the remainder of the COVID-19 declared emergency.
- Restrooms are not permitted for visitor use at this time.
- The facility reserves the right to modify our guidelines as necessary and will provide updates.

* Limited, extenuating exceptions will be determined on a case-by-case basis.
