



Welcome to Caponi's Cannolis School of the Arts!

We are so happy to have you with us this season. We are creating this document so that you are aware that our goal for all classes is to create an environment that is as normal as possible for your children, while still following the suggested CDC guidelines. In addition to this document, we are asking that you have read our additional policy page from our website, which includes information about bullying, attendance, W/D's, etc.

Here are the things we are NOT able to guarantee

1. Please be aware that we cannot guarantee children will be kept 3 feet apart from each other at all times. We will encourage students to sit farther apart, and we will not do any activities where the children will need to hold hands. However, during scene blocking (musical theater classes) and chorus rehearsals (Show Chorus), your child will be in a closer proximity to other children and may be required to stand within 3 feet from another actor.
2. We will not be requiring the students to wear masks, but they will be fully supported if they would like to wear one. However, we do not encourage them to be worn during any physical or singing activity, such as learning choreography or vocal instruction. If you are requiring your child to wear a mask and would rather them not remove it at any time, we may have to remove them from high aerobic choreography scenes for their best interest. Wireless mics may be used during the performance, but they will not be shared with another actor.

Here is what we will be doing

1. We will be following guidelines for cleaning our facility. Door handles, bathroom, tables, chairs will be sanitized before and after class.
2. We are also going to have hand washing during our breaks. We will have hand sanitizer readily available in many locations throughout studio. If you have one you would rather your child use, please have them bring it in, but only to be used by the individual child. No Sharing.
3. Children will not be allowed to share food or drinks. With that being said, all students need to bring their own lunches and snacks each and every class (if applicable). This normally only applies with our summer camps. Please do not come to the studio and drop off lunches or snacks from restaurants or outside sources. We are limiting any extra traffic in our studio.

4. Your child will be provided with their own script or sheet music to use- however, if they forget, they may be able to borrow one from the studio. Please bring their own pencils, hi-lighters, and pens for note taking. If possible, try and have small pencil bag or ziploc to put it in.
5. We will be posting a sign the CDC recommends reminding students to wash their hands.
6. We will be providing designated areas for the children to keep their belongings separate that will only be used by them throughout rehearsals.
7. An 'ear' thermometer will be on-site in case we need to do temperature checks.

Here is what we are requiring from parents and/or guardians

1. If your child has a fever higher than 99.9, please do not send them to class.
2. Please encourage your child wash their hands in our bathroom prior to coming into our main room.
4. At pick up, we are asking that parents go to the back end of the studio parking area and children will be released 'car rider' style. Please remain in your cars and we will walk children to the car one at a time. We will be using walkie talkies to communicate with a second instructor when you are pulling up to call out your child. If you have an old car rider tag from your child's school, that will help us or you can create your own sign to display to make it easier for us to see. We will be texting you a picture of the layout for the entrance and exit. If someone else is picking up your child, please let us know.
3. Please discuss these guidelines with your children.
