There is a concert immediately following the festival and the parking lot needs to be cleared as quickly as possible. Please recruit a friend or two to help fill the gap. Very important: Volunteers are **not** allowed to drink before OR during their Volunteer shift as a professional courtesy. Please do not wear your souvenir t-shirt when you are enjoying the festival on your own time.

- Dress is black or khaki shorts or pants for everyone, jeans are acceptable and comfortable shoes are a must. You will be standing or walking in most cases. Everyone will be given a volunteer t-shirt to wear when they arrive. (Make sure to allow time to change.)
- Parking can be difficult during the event, particularly if you are volunteering on later shifts. Plan to allow at least 30 minutes to park. For those of you on the second shift, you may want to allow more time. Volunteer parking is across the street at old YOLO building. You will cross 98 at the light, a deputy should be there for traffic control. Car pool if possible, parking will be tight!
- All volunteers will check in before their shift at Volunteer Check In, corner of the Town Centre immediately on your right as you enter the parking lot. Water and light snacks will be available at this table during the day too.
- We will also provide a Fisher House lanyard for you to wear that raises awareness of the great organization you are representing. Volunteer shirts are not to be worn when drinking. The shirt is yours to keep after the event as a souvenir of the great event! Please drop the lanyard off at the check in tent when leaving.
- Purses, keys, valuables, etc. should be securely stored prior to arrival. Lockers are not available and we want your items safe.
- Please be flexible as you are volunteering. There may be times when you may be moved to various locations depending on where more help is needed each day. We want this to be a great experience for everyone...volunteers and patrons.
- Typically this crowd is a little more youthful and spirited as it coincides with spring break for Destin, intentional on behalf of the organizers. Please maintain your helpful, friendly approach and let event organizers know of any concerns you have during the festival. Safety, responsibility and good behavior by all is the goal!
- In closing, this event could raise substantial funds to bless our military families so we are able to care for them during a medical event. The donation of your time makes that possible through fundraising from this event.
