Convenes and oversees a volunteer advisory council of local ordained Christian ministers. Reaches out to a diverse body of students through collaboration across the university. Animates the Catholic and Marianist vision of the University through ministry across Christian traditions as an active collaborator on the 30+ person Campus Ministry. Serves on the Campus Ministry Leadership Team.
