Dear Members of Temple Anshei Shalom,

We are all aware of the current situation with Covid-19. In order to invite congregants into our building there are a few things that you need to know. We are planning on allowing the **first 25 members who call to attend Friday evening services at 7:00 pm on April 9, 2021**. All attendees must meet the requirements described in this letter. Please know that services will also be available for viewing with Zoom and Streaming.

You will be selected to attend in the order that your calls are received. You may be allowed to attend twice per month until we are fully opened. These arrangements may change. No food is being served. Please do not socialize inside the building.

The only doors that will be open will be the lobby doors. All other doors will remain locked. You will enter and leave only through the lobby doors.

In order that we are ALL as safe and healthy as possible, we ask that you obey the following rules:

- Reservations **must be made with the office before April 6 2021**. Please call Kari in the TAS office at (561) 495-1300 and let her know that you (and your partner/spouse) would like to be put on the list to attend services. **Only** Members in Good standing (members who have made financial arrangements or have paid their dues in full for 2021) will be allowed to attend services.
- You must then fill out the attached Waiver and Health Verification Form and drop it off (or mail it in) to the office. **It must be received before April 6, 2021. If we do not have a signed Waiver, you will not be allowed to attend.**
- On April 9 (and/or each time you attend services) you must prove that at least two weeks have passed since you have received both shots (of either the Moderna or Pfizer vaccines) by **showing your vaccination card** to the Usher at the door. (One Shot for the Johnson & Johnson)
- At this time, care givers (aides) will not be permitted to enter the building. Ushers will assist you in walking to your seat, if needed.
- Your temperature will be taken at the door by an Usher.
- You will be directed to a seat in the sanctuary. All seats have the words **Reserved** on them to identify them as seats that may be used. You may not change your seat. You can only sit next to a family member who lives with you. All others will be seated separately.
- You **MUST** wear a mask at **ALL TIMES** while in the building.
- Kipot/head coverings will not be available. You must bring your own.
- If any of the above are not followed, you will be asked to leave by an Usher.

Please see the attached Waiver and return your signed Waiver to the office.

Dear Temple Anshei Shalom Members,

Please read the WAIVER and Health Verification below and sign and return this form to the Temple before April 6, 2021.

Covid 19 is highly contagious and can lead to illness or death and there is a risk of exposure in any public place or event. Applicable CDC procedures and protocols have been implemented as we attempt to provide a safe environment for worship. The building will be sanitized and social distancing will be maintained. We are permitting attendance only for persons who have been fully vaccinated and restricting in-person attendance from anyone with knowledge that they have a Covid-19 infection or have recently been exposed to the virus.

You hereby agree to the following:

By attending Temple Anshei Shalom Shabbat Services during the Covid-19 pandemic. **I agree to abide** by the procedures established by the Temple to protect attendees and staff. I voluntarily assume the risk that I may be exposed to or infected by Covid -19 by entering the Temple building and participating in services and I waive any liability against the Temple, its Officers, Directors, members, agents and employees and any other parties arising out of, or related to, my attendance at services. By signing this, I fully understand all provisions of this Waiver and release and freely and knowingly assume all the risks related to Covid-19 exposure. I agree to follow the Usher's and other staff instructions.

Each of the undersigned also verifies that I do not have a Covid-19 infection and I am not currently experiencing or displaying and have not in the prior 14 days experience or displayed any of the symptoms of Covid-19 and have not been exposed to COVID-19 and have not traveled out of the State of Florida in the prior 14 days.

If you cannot affirm any of the above statements on the day of services, please do not attend.

Please sign and date this form and send/drop it off at the Temple office by **April 6, 2021**. Then call the office (561-495-1300) and RESERVE your seat. This Waiver will be kept on file for future services, but you are prohibited from attending any future in-person services if there is any change in your Covid-19 health status.
