What is Milford Trunk-or-Treat? Milford businesses, shops and organizations are decking out their car trunks with spooky Halloween decorations and passing out candy to children and families. This fun will be a safe, socially distanced family event.

Why Trunk-or-Treat? Milford LOVES Halloween! But we also know that many residents may not feel comfortable opening their doors to trick-or-treaters this year. And many parents might not feel at ease bringing their kids to visit homes. Trunk-or-Treat is a safe alternative to traditional trick or treating.

Does that mean Halloween in Milford is Cancelled? No. Halloween is not cancelled. This is just another option for families with school-aged kids to participate in the Halloween fun.

Will Trunk-or-Treat be Safe? Yes! Many community volunteers will be on hand to make sure that there is social distancing and safe candy distribution. Participants will be wearing masks too. We are taking direction from the CDC and local health experts.

Do I need to register to participate? No, you don't need to register. Just come to Gooseberry Alley at High Street and our volunteers will guide families through the Trunk-or-Treat in small, safe groups.

I've decided not to open my house this year to trick or treaters. Is there any way I can get involved? Yes! You can donate candy for our local trick-or-treaters. If you donate candy for 50 kids, we will give you a poster for your house that says that you are participating in Trunk-or-Treat this year instead of traditional trick or treating.

I want to donate candy! What do I do next? All you have to do is drop off enough candy for 50 kids off at:

You can drop off your candy donation Monday through Friday between 8am and 4pm beginning on October 19th. When you drop off your candy, we will give you a poster for your home that directs trick-or-treaters to Trunk-or-Treat. It's as easy as that.
