



Permanent Cosmetics After Care



Thank you for choosing Premier Cosmetic Solutions Permanent Cosmetics. The latest cosmetics, inks, and equipment have been used in your procedure.

In order to obtain the best results from your permanently enhanced features, care instructions and tips are listed below.

✂ For the next five days, please:

- ✂ Apply Color Sealant to the new procedure area five (5) times daily. The area should be kept hydrated, but not oversaturated, for the best color retention.
- ☞ Color Sealant must be kept on in order to prevent drying, scabbing, and falling off. This will result in the loss of color.
 - ✂ Small granules of color you may feel with the tips of your fingers are normal and not scabbing. Gently buff the area with warm water and cotton pads in a circular motion and apply Color Sealant.
- ☞ If the sealant causes continuous burning, stop immediately and apply Vitamin E Oil instead. It is not as good as the Color Sealant, but is an adequate substitute.
 - ✂ Do NOT use anything with petroleum, as it clogs the pores and prevents color retention.

✂ For the next five days, do not:

- ✂ Scratch, tweeze, or wax on or around the procedure area. This may cause color loss.
- ✂ Swim, soak in a hot tub, take intensely hot baths, or overly sweat. Water does not affect the procedure, however steam, chlorine, and salt may cause color loss.
- ✂ Apply makeup on or around the procedure—especially around the eyes. The bacteria found in makeup may cause an infection. If you must use makeup, please use new product.
- ✂ Use cleanser or scrub with any item around or on the procedure area. This may result in color loss.
- ✂ Use Retin-A or other harsh products at all. It will migrate to the procedure area and result in color loss.

✂ Please be aware of the following:

- ✂ The eye area is most likely to swell, especially with thicker or mucosal eyeliner procedures.
 - ☞ If irritation or redness occurs and does not subside within four hours of your procedure, flush the eye with saline solution, and wipe the area with warm water and a cotton pad. Use Vitamin E Oil around eye instead.
- ✂ To reduce swelling of any area, place an ice pack wrapped in a wet paper towel directly on the area. The longer the ice remains—a maximum of 20 minutes—the better.
 - ☞ Even if the area does not appear swollen, it is traumatized. Icing the area will prevent any future swelling.
- ✂ The procedure area will look dark for four to five days before lightening. Do not judge the color, shape, or size of your permanent makeup until you are completely healed, which may take up to eight (8) weeks.
 - ☞ Mucosal skin, such as the lips and lower eyelid, may take six to eight weeks to show color. This is due to the unique way mucosal skin heals.
 - ☞ Your second application is when we assess how well your skin takes to permanent makeup. Any shape and color adjustments will be made during this visit. You may schedule your retouch application eight weeks after your initial procedure.

Your new look* should last an average of one to three years* for translucent colors and five to nine years for opaque colors, depending on sun exposure, cosmetics used on the face, and skin type. In certain instances, procedures may have to be touched up sooner.
