Hopkinsville, KY October 7, 2020 – Hopkinsville Christian County Public Library (HCCPL) continues to reinstate library services and access for library patrons.

The library has been open to the public with limited services since June 8th. They are slowly reinstating and adding new services for patrons. Currently the following services are available to the public:

- Passport processing
- Book-A-Bike checkouts
- Computers and printing
- Faxing, copying, & scanning services
- Book & DVD checkouts
- Book sale
- WIFI access 24/7 in the area immediately surrounding the library
- Dolly Parton Imagination Library registration
- Library card sign-up
- eBooks, audiobooks, & magazines through the Libby App
- *Grab and Go Activities* – **New Service**
- *Curbside pick-up* – **New Service**
- *Senior Citizen/compromised immune system hours* – **New Service**
- *Create your own Book Bundles* – **New Service**

DeeAnna Sova, Executive Director, shared, “HCCPL continues to follow all COVID-19 guidelines, including requiring masks while inside the building, social distancing, cleaning all materials returned to the library, sanitizing computers after each use, and sanitizing public surfaces. We unfortunately do not have tables and chairs available for patron use, but we are working on a limited number of study tables that can be reserved for specific times for students. We hope to share that and other new services in the following months.”

“HCCPL has offered library services since the first day of the COVID-19 shutdown by providing free books to the community,” Ms. Sova added, “We are happy to continue to listen and respond to the needs of our patrons as we work together during this unprecedented time. We realize that our public library is a vital part of our community for entertainment, student access to research materials, and a hub for job training and employment searches.”
