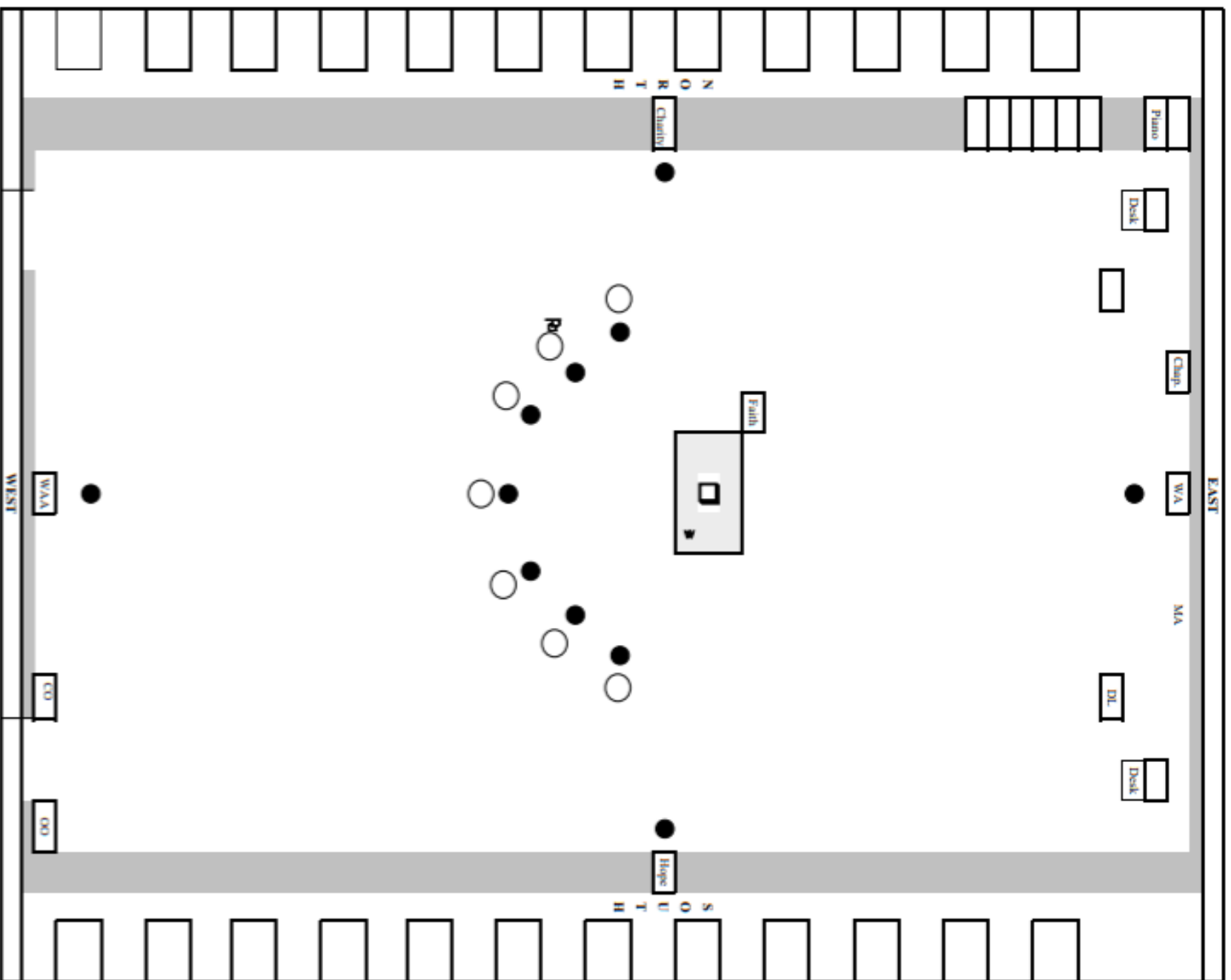




# Binder

- What is the purpose of the COVID19 Binder?
- Prepare a binder that contains or provides space for the following:

- Blank permission slips
- Completed permission slips
- Blank COVID Questionnaires
- Completed COVID Questionnaires for each activity
- Reservation lists for in person meetings
- Blank seating charts for the lodge room and banquet room
- Seating charts from previously held meetings
- Site Prevention Plan for meeting location (Masonic Lodge)
- Keep a running list of vaccinated adults so they don't have to show card each time

# General Procedures

- Complete a permission slip and a COVID 19 Questionnaire provide.
- Youth and Adults 18 years of age or older documentation of either a recent (within 72 hours) negative COVID 19 test or full vaccination (all doses as well as required waiting period completed).
- Two COVID 19 trained adults must be designated to check-in registered attendees and ensure completion of all required documentation
- Parents/Membership events must follow guidelines
- All activities and meetings must be approved by the Assembly Advisory Board.
- Masks are required at all times (except when eating socially distanced)





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# Refreshments

- Food may be store bought or homemade
- All food must be individually wrapped
- Drinks must be single serve bottles, cans, or cartons
- Everyone must maintain six (6) feet of social distance while eating (unless part of same household)
- Wash hands before eating and have hand sanitizer in the food area

# Indoor Meeting and Activity Procedures

- Refreshments?
- Seating chart?
- What is your reservation system?
- How many feet?
- Seating capacity designated by state, county, or city guidelines or as directed by the Site Prevention Plan
- Some site plans don't include the lodge dining room, consider grab and go bagged snacks

If your lodge isn't opening, reach out to the Inspector to see about another lodge for meeting space.



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## Ritual Modifications Opening Ceremony

1. Jewels shall not be set out.
2. Sanitizing bottles should be placed at all line officer stations as well as the stations of Confidential and Outer Observer
3. Sanitize all items that will be touched before the meeting
  1. The Bible should carefully be wiped down with sanitizer cloths and placed on the Altar. (no one should be escorting in the Bible at this time)
  2. Hope, Charity, WAA, & WA should also sanitize their gavels and sounding blocks if used.
  3. Confidential and Outer Observer should sanitize the doors before using
4. Bow chairs may be offset if able to maintain the 6ft. of social distancing. If not possible, remove Nature, Immortality, and Patriotism's chairs from the bow.
5. The American Flag shall be placed in its usual position. .
6. All officers, members, guests, and adults must remain six (6) feet apart.
7. Officers will start the meeting at their stations; there shall be no entrance or marches.
8. Floor work will not be done to prove the Assembly.



# Ritual Modifications

## Opening Ceremony

1. When officers are to touch the Bible, doors, gavels, or etc.. they are to sanitize their hands before and after.
  1. Hope should sanitize her hands at her station before and after opening the Bible. Or she may wear non-latex gloves if she prefers.
  2. Before and After each time the Confidential and Outer Observer rap they should sanitize their hands.
2. The Chaplain, Worthy Advisor, and Mother Advisor shall sit six (6) feet apart.
3. The Drill Leader and Recorder stations shall remain six (6) feet apart.
4. There shall be no singing during the meeting.
5. Before and After each time the Confidential and Outer Observer rap they should sanitize their hands.
6. The American Flag will remain in its stand; the Worthy Advisor will rap the Assembly up and ask the audience to recite the Pledge of Allegiance from their seats.
7. Hope and Charity stand and stay at their stations. Charity can ask all to rise. They should look around and be sure that all in attendance are entitled to be there. They should not leave their stations to collect the 'word'.
8. Introductions shall be made with the person introduced remaining at their seat.



# Ritual Modifications

## Closing Ceremony

1. When officers are to touch the Bible, doors, gavels, or etc.. they are to sanitize their hands before and after.
  1. Before and after each time the Confidential and Outer Observer rap they should sanitize their hands.
  2. Hope should sanitize her hands at her station before and after opening the Bible. Or she may wear non-latex gloves if she prefers.
2. Please remember you are able to repeat the Rainbow Prayer at your seats after the meeting.



# Outdoor Activities Procedures!

- All general procedures for in person activities must be followed:
- Must use all required forms (permission slip, questionnaire)
  - Must take temperatures
  - All documentation must be placed in the binder.
  - Must remain 6 feet apart and masks must be worn at all times

Attendance may not exceed the guidelines prescribed by the state, county, or city wherein the activity is held.

- Purple Tier Counties = 50 people
- Red Tier Counties = 50 people
- Orange Tier Counties = 100 people
- Yellow Tier Counties = 200 people

**COVID Testing and proof of full vaccination are not required**





# Exposure Procedures

- If an exposure to COVID 19 occurs at an Assembly activity or meeting, the following procedure shall be followed:
- The Mother Advisor or Chairman notifies the following:
  - Grand Deputy/Area Grand Deputy
  - Email: [caiorg.covid19@gmail.com](mailto:caiorg.covid19@gmail.com) for guidance and further instructions
  - The Assembly discontinues all in person activities or meetings for two weeks and until given clearance by the Supreme Inspector.

- Vaccine and testing protocols not required at Approved Outdoor Events
- Masks and Social Distancing ARE required at Approved Outdoor Events
