All applicants must show proof of finances. Please obtain an official letter from the bank or financial institution in which you, and /or your sponsor, have available funds. This letter should be written on official letterhead, in English, and signed by a bank official. This letter should state the date the account was open, the currency types and specifically states an amount that is currently in the account. Bank letters dated more than two months from the date of submission to the Montessori Training Center of Minnesota are considered expired. If dependents will accompany you, please use the three-summer figure plus the additional cost of dependents.

All sponsors must also provide a letter of commitment (an affidavit). This letter must include your full name, the relationship between you and the sponsor, the amount and duration of their support, and the sponsor’s telephone number, address, and their original signature.

If the sponsorship is from an organization (government or private) it must provide you a letter of sponsorship on official letterhead with the organization’s address, telephone and fax number, and the original signature and title of the responsible official. This letter should also include your full name, the specific dollar amount and duration of sponsorship.
