In order to be considered for scholarship assistance (even if you have received scholarship funds in the past) you must:

1. Complete and sign this application
2. Provide proof of income

Proof of income includes:

1. Your most recent IRS tax return and Federal 1040 and/or W2
2. One month paycheck stubs for all working adults in the household
3. Benefits letters from your county
4. Employer letter verifying cash income (for example, housing, day labor, etc.)

Anyone seeking a scholarship may apply. Scholarships are granted based on need, at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee. Eligibility and monthly payments are determined based on the federal poverty level for your family size. You will be notified in writing of any scholarship granted to you. You will be responsible to report any changes in family size or income. Scholarships may be decreased or eliminated based on economic availability, per the committee's discretion. The minimum monthly contribution to your child's tuition is \$15 per family.
