<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also required us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
<b>What?</b>	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Social Security Number and Income</li> <li>• credit scores and employment information</li> <li>• payment history and credit history</li> </ul>
<b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons

<b>What we do</b>	
<b>How does</b>	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.  Your information is stored on servers that are housed at a secure managed data center facility and protected via firewall, multiple intrusion detection systems, regular penetration testing, continuous monitoring, and annual SSAE 16 Type II audits.
<b>How does</b>	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• apply for a loan or provide your mortgage information</li> <li>• provide employment information or give us your income information</li> <li>• show your driver's license</li> </ul> We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
<b>Why can't I limit all sharing?</b>	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>• affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>• sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> </ul> State Laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
<b>What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?</b>	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account - unless you tell us otherwise.
<b>Definitions</b>	
<b>Affiliates</b>	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  <i>has no affiliates.</i>
<b>Nonaffiliates</b>	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Nonaffiliates we share with can include First American Title; Fidelity National Title; American Integrity Escrow; ARC; AMS, Credit Plus.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Joint marketing</b>	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>doesn't jointly market.</i></li> </ul>
