The Wanda Joyce Robinson Foundation:

- Formed a Board of Directors and obtained non-profit status, September, 2018
- Received 80+ referrals from inmates, DCBS, schools, parents/caregivers
- Has served 200+ individual children and youth
- Met with multiple politicians to advocate for policy change
- Met with Superintendent Houston Barber, (FIS), and Superintendent Mark Kopp, (FCS), to establish a partnership with both school systems.
- Provided holiday assistance to 49 kids
- Provided college/career prep planning for high school seniors, with Kim Walters Parker, a national educational consultant, and a team of volunteers. (This is an ongoing outreach to high school students.)
- Partnered with Franklin County High School and Western Hills High School to take 14 students on a trip to Toyota
- Has sponsored 8 children in extracurricular activities
- Provided 40+ children with a “Guys/Girls” day outing to Malibu Jack’s and a crafting event at Coffeetree Cafe
- Capital City Christian Church rented out Capital Bowl for 29 children and families
- Started a bi-monthly outreach to The Kings Center, meeting with three groups of 20+ children
- Became a member of the Frankfort Area Chamber of Commerce
- Established five \$500 scholarships for graduating seniors
