

Galendromus occidentalis

(Russet Mite/Cyclamen Mite Control)



1. Take the bottle(s) out of the box & rest them on their side to warm up to room temperature.
2. Spray the plant leaves with water. This helps the predatory mites stick to the leaves.
3. Hold the bottle cap in one hand & the bottom of the bottle in the other, then rotate the bottle in your hands while gently rocking it back & forth. This evens out the concentration of mites within the bottle so you get an even, effective application.
4. Open the bottle, turn the bottom of the cap towards the leaves of the plant & flick the back of the cap, letting the predators on the inside of the lid shower down onto the plant. Now you are ready to shake them onto the plant.
5. Apply the proper amount of predators onto each plant while holding a paper plate (or something similar) under the leaves to catch whatever falls through.
- *6. One the vial is empty, place the bottle down on the growing medium, resting the bottle against the main stem. There will be some residual mites in the bottle. This allows them to crawl out onto the plant.
7. Turn the paper plate towards the most infested plant(s) and tap the back to allow the predators to shower down onto the plant just as you did the cap.
