



The Utah 1033 Foundation 2021 Leadership Award Program

Application Rules and Procedures

The Utah 1033 Foundation will award up to three (3) Fallen Hero Leadership Awards, each given in honor of Utah Peace Officers lost in the line of duty since the Utah 1033 Foundation's establishment, and each carrying a stipend of \$5,000, for post-secondary education to qualifying students in 2021, based on a competitive selection process. Winners will be notified in April, 2021. Leadership Award funds cannot be claimed without committed current enrollment at an accredited College, University, or Vocational Certificate Program, and must be claimed by August 31st, 2023.

Rules for Application to the Leadership Awards Program

- Must be a natural child, legally adopted child, or step-child of a actively employed sworn Utah peace officer
- Must have a cumulative High School GPA of at least 3.5 and a cumulative College/University/Vocational Certificate Program GPA of at least 3.3 (if applicable)
- Must be a currently enrolled High School Senior, or be currently enrolled in an accredited College, University, or Vocational Certificate Program as a full-time student
- Must be aged 25 or younger
- Must submit a complete application packet as described in the "How to Apply" section below via U.S. Mail, **postmarked no later than January 31st, 2021**
- No individual may win more than two Leadership Awards from the Utah 1033 Foundation
- Applicants may not be immediate family members of the Utah 1033 Foundation's staff or Governing Board
- Submitted materials will not be returned
- Candidates will be evaluated on the basis of their respective GPAs, course rigor, and the originality, leadership qualities, and depth of thought reflected in their response to the essay prompt
- Applicants not meeting the criteria as described in this section will not be considered or evaluated
- Incomplete applications will not be considered or evaluated
- Any submitted materials not requested in the "How to Apply" section below will not be considered or evaluated
- Once applicable, each Award recipient agrees to notify The Utah 1033 Foundation of his or her graduation date from College, University, or Vocational Certificate Program, and of the degree or certificate earned

To apply, please submit the following:

- Completed Application Form, signed by both the Applicant and the Qualifying Parent/Guardian (see page 2 below)
- Completed Release Form, signed by both the Applicant and the Qualifying Parent/Guardian (see page 3 below)
- A three-page (maximum), double spaced essay in response to the prompt provided on the Application Form
- Official High School **and** College/University/Vocational Certificate Program transcripts (if applicable). An official high school transcript *must* be submitted. **NOTE: Please ensure that all submitted transcripts are marked OFFICIAL by the issuing institution; self-reported transcripts (i.e. transcripts printed by the student from the institution's web portal, etc.) will not be considered.**
- Self-picture (for use on website, media releases and other marketing materials)
- Please be sure your name is on every sheet of paper submitted, including the essay
- **Submit all required items in a single package to The Utah 1033 Foundation, ATTN: Leadership Awards Program, P.O. Box 4522, Park City, UT 84060. Applications must be postmarked by January 31, 2021.**

II. Required Essay Topic

Please include a separate essay (no more than three pages, double spaced) in response to the following prompt. Please feel free to conduct research and to ask friends, parents, teachers, mentors, colleagues, etc. for their opinions and knowledge –the more research you do and the more you discuss this topic with others before sitting down to write, the more “tested” your ideas may be, but please write the essay in your own voice and make sure it represents your own work, with references cited for any non-original thoughts and arguments per MLA works cited guidelines.

- The lines of definition between 1) peaceful protest, 2) civil disobedience, and 3) civil rebellion/violent protest can become blurred in theory and in practice. What is perhaps intended as a “peaceful protest” may also involve illegal activity, inadvertently or not, if, say, traffic is unlawfully blocked or a curfew is broken, or a contract or Constitutional right is interfered with (e.g. a “peaceful protest” blocks an invited guest speaker at a public university from speaking). Situations can also become conflated when different groups with different agendas and goals gather together. So, how would *you* define each term? If a law is broken through protest, can it still be called “peaceful protest?” Does it depend on the nature of the law broken, or on intent? Does it matter whether the act is done by an individual or by a group? If an act of “civil disobedience” involves an act of violence, does it automatically become “civil rebellion/violent protest?” Does it depend on the nature of the violence? Finally, which form(s) of protest, according to your definitions, would you defend or not defend?
