ADMINISTRATIVE RESOLUTION NO. 203

NO SOLICITATION POLICY: COMMON AREA AND COMMON FACILITIES

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 3 (c) (2) of the Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions authorizes the Board of Directors of the CountrySide Proprietary to establish rules and regulations for the use of property in the Membership's best interests; and

WHEREAS, for the benefit and protection of the Proprietary and of the individual Member, the Board deems it desirable to discourage solicitation on common area and at common facilities in an attempt to minimize potential personal harm and material risk to community members; and

WHEREAS, for the purpose of establishing Board policy in the area of solicitation on common area and at common facilities, there is a need to formulate and adopt formal rules and procedures for publication of this policy;

WHEREAS, the Board desires to rescind Administrative Resolution No. 191 and hereby substitutes Administrative Resolution No. 203.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the following rules and procedures for the adoption of a NO SOLICITATION POLICY be established:

- I. "No Solicitation" signs shall be installed at the four main entrances of CountrySide with the three entrances to the Welbourne neighborhood.
- II. Notice of the "No Solicitation Policy" shall be forwarded to the Loudoun County Sheriff's Department and any other County agencies deemed appropriate.
- III. Publication of the "No Solicitation Policy" shall be given to present membership through the monthly newsletter.
- IV. Exemption be given to the Sterling Fire/Rescue to solicit for donations provided they are properly identified i.e. dressed in uniform and solicit only at the front door of homes.
