

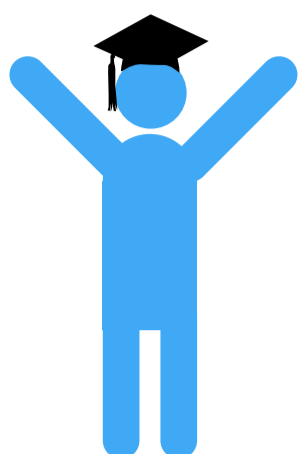

Collegiate Female



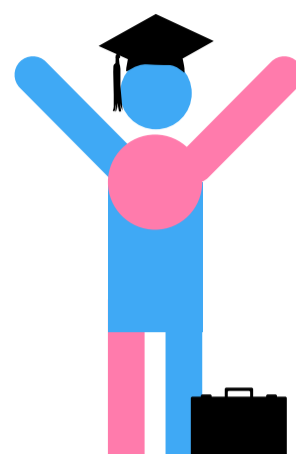

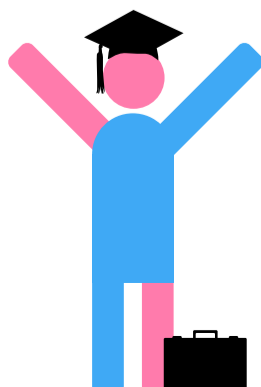
