PARADE RULES

1. The Committee needs time to organize the parade line-up and prepare the script for our announcer. **Your entry form must be in no later than June 27, 2019.**
2. Throwing/tossing of any articles from the Parade such as candy, balloons, gum, literature, **or anything** is a violation of the Litter Law and prohibited by our insurance. Throwing items is dangerous and may cause an accident by enticing a child into the parade route.
3. Handing out candy **or anything else requires prior approval by the Parade Committee.** If your request is approved, you will receive individual instruction. **Violation of this rule will get your entry ejected on the spot, even during the Parade, and banned for the following year.** No one will be allowed to cause circumstances that could endanger another person.
4. The Parade Committee reserves the right to exclude any Entry not displaying the American flag in good taste and in accordance with the Federal Flag Code.
5. Racing of motors is prohibited.
6. Sorry, no animals will be allowed in the Parade.
7. Cooperation with Parade Officials is mandatory.
