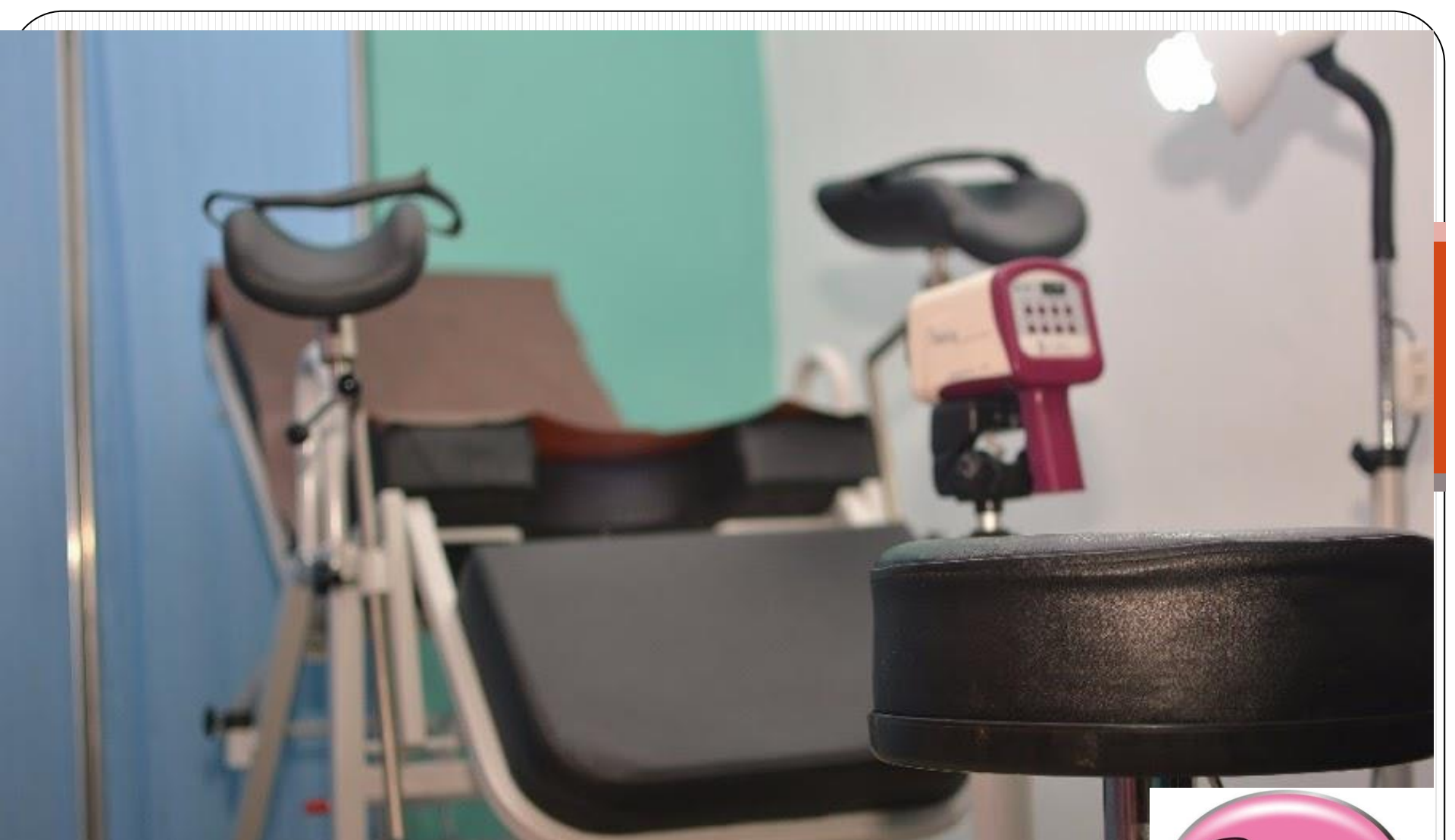

 - Oct 2017-Till date.
 - In partnership with ACT Foundation, LSMOH PHCB
 - 12,000+ women for cervical cancer
 - 3% VIA positive lesions(Acetowhite)
 - 1% -CIN lesions
- Lead CSO-Demand Generation for cervical cancer screening in Lagos State,UNITAID,LSMOH,CHAI,FMOH, LSPHCB
- HPV Vaccination:Walk in and Online requests via the Oncopadi Mobile App
