### Tires:

#### **All events, all weekend**

Left Front: American Racer 33/44 Compound (any track stamp)

Right Front: American Racer 38/44 Compound (any track stamp)

Left Rear: American Racer 44 Compound (any track stamp)

Right Rear: American Racer 53 Compound (any track stamp)

\*\*\*\*\* *Standard dirt modified tire ONLY permitted*\*\*\*\*\*

### Bodies:

DIRT Legal Bodies Only. <https://bridgeportmotorsportspark.com/>

### Radios:

In-car radios are required, *Channel 971*. No two-way communication permitted.

### Transponders:

AMB Transponders are required. Please be sure they are properly charged.

### Registration:

Car Registration \$50 – all pre-registered cars will draw before day of the race registered cars.

## PROCEDURES:

### Friday Night 602 Underdog Event

- This event is for 602 drivers that did NOT win in 2021 at any track in the 602 division.
- Drivers will get 2 sessions of warm-ups. The second session is timed.
- Top 6 in time will redraw.
- If over 34 cars we may split into two Underdog 20 events.
- Winner locks into 15<sup>th</sup> starting spot of Saturday's feature. Driver can better his position in Saturday Qualifying.

### Saturday Event Qualifying:

- Minimum of **5 Drivers** will qualify for Sundays race based on time.
- Drivers fastest overall time from Saturday will factor into Sundays heat race starting position.

### Sunday Event Qualifying:

- All Drivers will draw a number from bingo ball machine.
  - Bingo number + Saturdays timed position will be added together and then divided by 2 to determine your "final draw" number. This "final draw" number will be used to line driver up for heat race. In the event of a tie of the "final draw" number, fastest time will supersede.
  - If you do not time on Saturday, your timed position will be determined first come to pit shack on Sunday after all the drivers that timed on Saturday.
  - Examples –
    - Brady draws a 9 and timed 41<sup>st</sup> = 50 divide by 2 = 25 "final draw" number
    - Deegan draws a 52 and timed 2<sup>nd</sup> = 54 divide by 2 = 27 "final draw" number
    - Brittany draws 25 and times 23<sup>rd</sup> = 48 divide by 2 = 24 "final draw" number
- "Final draw" number will determine heat race starting position.
- Heat race top finishers (determined based on number of heat races) will redraw for feature starting position.

- All other qualified cars from Heats and B Main race will line up, heads up.

**Race Format – 40 laps:**

1. All starts and restarts will take place at orange cone located in turn 4.
2. After the completion of one scored lap. Leader will have choice of inside or outside.
3. Restarts in feature event will be double file until 5 laps to go.
4. Drivers involved in a caution will go to the rear of the cars on their respective lap.
5. Driver involved in a 360, keeps on moving and no one else stops, but yellow is thrown for safety, goes to the rear.
6. Lapped Cars will drop to the rear in the order they are running at the time of the caution flag.  
The top running lapped car at the time of the caution will be waved around to the tail end of the lead lap cars.
7. Lead lap cars returning to the track or involved in a caution and are still on the lead lap will line up in front of lapped cars.
8. Race is considered official after halfway.

**PAID Heat Races**

- Minimum of \$100 contingency gift certificate to the winner.
