1. SOMETHING GREEN THAT GROWS

A large, empty rectangular box with a thin black border, intended for drawing or describing a green object that grows.

2. SOMETHING THAT FLIES IN THE AIR

3. SOMETHING THAT CRAWLS AROUND

4. SOMETHING COLORFUL

A large, empty rectangular box with a thin black border, intended for drawing or describing something that makes you happy.

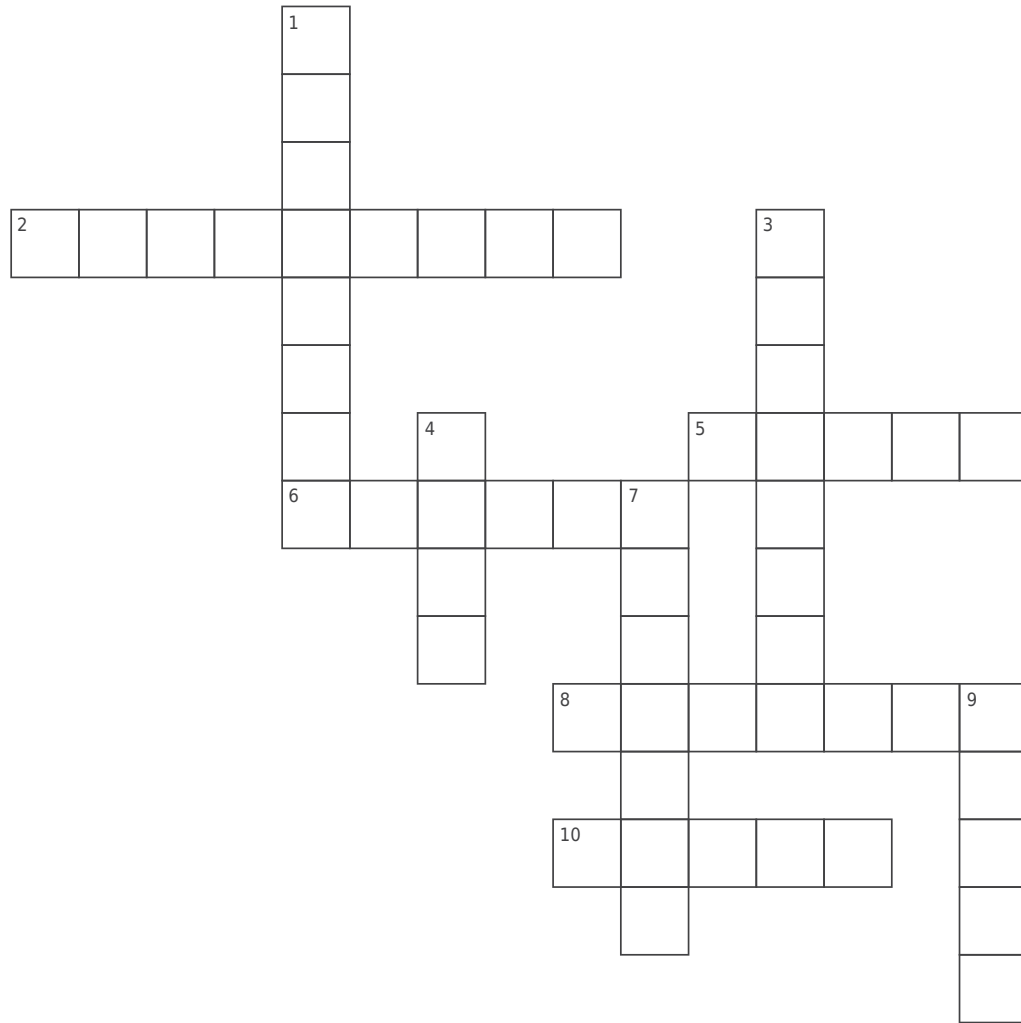


ACTIVITY SHEET 3

DOWN:

- 1 Famous in Louisiana, these sweet and fluffy warm pastries covered with white powdered sugar
- 3 Hard-shelled creature that is often referred to as a “mud bug”
- 4 Crustacean that has large pinchers and walks sideways along the beach
- 7 Large bird that is the state bird of Louisiana
- 9 Food dish loved by Louisianians that resembles a stew and is typically served over rice

ACROSS:

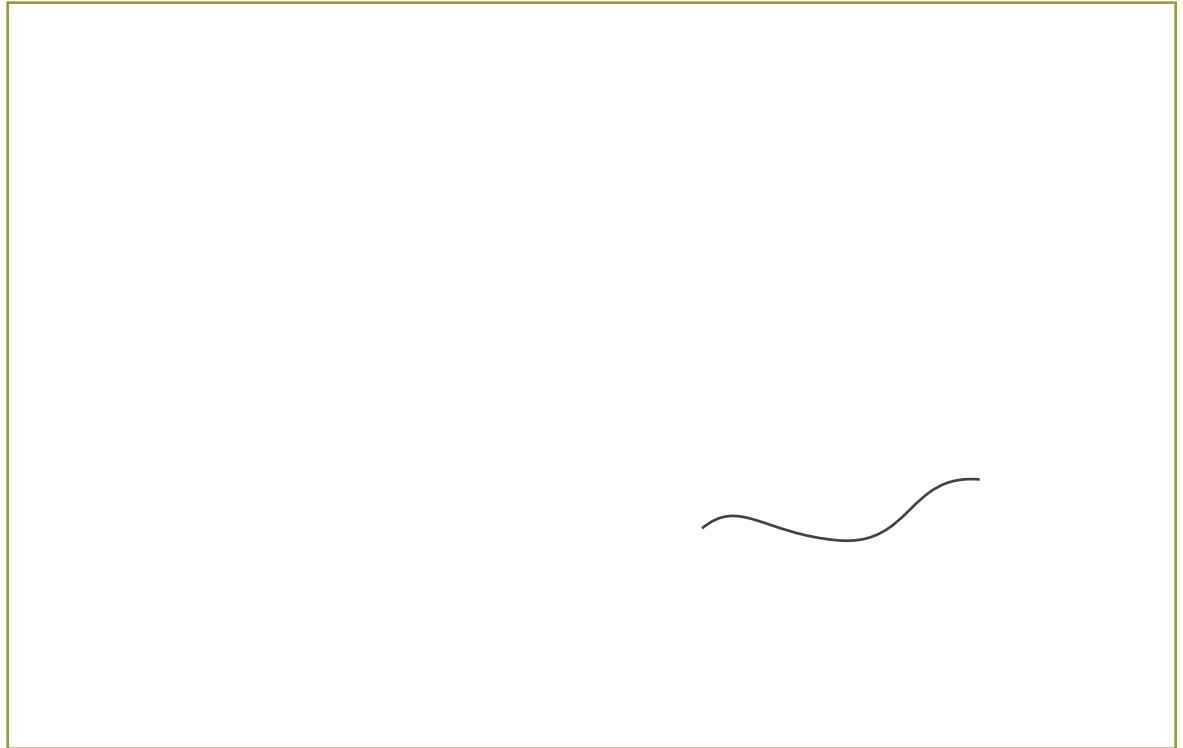
- 2 Reptile that lives in the water and has a big, long mouth
