TABSE Conference Constitution and Bylaws
Resolution #3

Whereas Article V/Executive Board, Section 2/Terms, states, No person may serve more than two consecutive full terms on the Executive Board, except to complete a term as an elected officer.

Whereas to clarify the purpose and intent of this bylaw, to limit an executive board member to serving no more than two (2) consecutive 2-year terms in one office. And whereas the intent is not to exclude an executive board member, who has faithfully served 4 years in one office, from seeking to serve on the executive board in another office or to seek the same office in future years.

Therefore, Be It Resolved that Article V/Executive Board, Section 2/Terms, be clarified. **Hence, Article V/Executive Board, Section 2/Terms shall state, Executive Board Members shall be elected to serve in their respective offices for a term of two years or until their successors are duly elected and installed. No Executive Board Member shall be eligible to serve more than two consecutive terms or a maximum of four (4) consecutive years in the office he/she has been elected, except to complete a term as an elected officer.**
