**Our Mission:** Work alongside allied individuals and organizations, governing sport bodies, and government institutions to eradicate anti-Black racism and racial inequities in the sports sector; be the voice for Black, Indigenous and Persons of Colour members of our athletics sport community.

**About Us:** The Black Canadian Coaches Association is an organization comprised of individuals seeking positive change against systemic and institutional barriers within the Canadian sport sector. The BCCA intends to address the needs and concerns of Black community members in the sports industry.

The BCCA was founded in 2020 by Lee Anna Osei, St. Francis Xavier university varsity athletics coach and educator, and is co-chaired by fellow USports coaches Ryan Thorne (McGill University) and Tenicha Gittens (Concordia University). The inspiration for this project is credited to the thousands of Black leaders throughout Canadian sport history who have and continue to promote educational, physical, social, and cultural continuity to those they inspire. Being a coach is all about empowering others; we are trailblazers in Canadian heritage, and leaders through sport.

**Objectives:**

1. Collect race-based data that will inform evidence-based policies for BIPOC executives, coaches and student-athletes.
2. Develop and create culturally competent anti-Black and anti-Indigenous training that can be administered by member institutions as well as inform policies.
3. Create a public platform (website) to raise continued awareness and education about racial inequities within our collegiate sport institutions and the broader sport community at large.

**Our Ask:** We are fundraising for the creation of The Charter for Racial Equity in Canadian Postsecondary Athletic Institutions; written legislation to be implemented within each governing sport institution.

**We are seeking financial assistance** to fund this project of collecting of race-based data that will inform our collegiate institutions where the most pressing needs and concerns are for our BIPOC student-athletes, coaches and executives within USports and the Canadian Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA). Your contribution goes towards the creation of sport and race related resources that can be administered at each governing institution.

**Monitoring Progress:**
