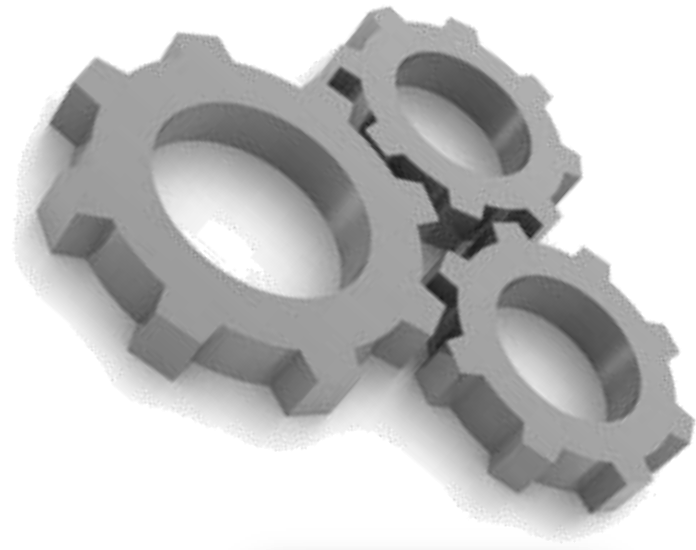


INDUSTRIAL MAINTENANCE



Why choose Industrial Technology?

If you like to work with your hands and interact with machines then this is the program for you. With lecture time limited to 20% or less, students gain valuable knowledge to prepare themselves for a rewarding career.



The average median income for an Industrial Technology graduate is \$20.37/hour. There are projected to be 2,940 job openings each year through 2020.

Students in the Industrial Maintenance Pathway will earn a thirty-four credit hour Technical Certificate in Industrial Technology, with an Industrial Mechanical concentration. The program is two years and will begin during the fall semester of junior year, and will include access to a work-based learning program through a paid internship.
