Eco-Grant Eligibility Guidelines

The project must:

1. be related to the environment in some way (sustainable elements, innovation, use of recycled/reused materials, etc.)
2. be local (Fremont, Newark, and Union City)
3. be community related (Scouts, school, non-profit, church)
4. be on public or quasi-public property
5. normally, not be wholly dependent on our funding (we like spending locally if possible and sensible)
6. be a project as opposed to simply a purchase
7. not require repetitive funding

Applicants must make a presentation to the Board of Directors as to how their project meets the guidelines above, and must agree to provide a final written report to the Board upon completion. The report should describe the results of the project, the specific impact of our participation, and lessons learned from the experience. The Board of Directors may make exceptions when justified.

Statement for the application

Each year, the ecology center sets aside approximately \$1200 of Eco-Grant funds for young people and adults working on local environmental projects. The projects must be educational and/or aesthetic in nature. The specific guidelines are listed on the back of the application. Please review them, along with the items on the form above, to determine if you qualify.
