FREE HIV and Hepatitis C Testing

Monday-Friday , 9am-7:45pm Saturday & Sunday 9am-4:30pm

- Photo ID required, no appointment needed
- Must be age 13 years or older; no parent or guardian necessary
- Results provided in as little as 15 minutes

FREE STI (Sexually Transmitted Infection) Testing

Monday-Friday 9am-4pm, provided by the Florida Health Department

- Photo ID required, no appointment needed
- Must be age 13 years or older; no parent or guardian necessary
- Repeat testing allowed after 3 months; no testing within 3 days of menstruation
- Results available within 2 weeks (results provided in-person ONLY with photo ID)

FREE Online Mental Health Counseling

Monday-Saturday, three therapist to choose from

- Telehealth services include completing intake paperwork
- Max of SIX (6) sessions, after which the counselor will be able to refer to another counselor based on their needs
- Couple & Family counseling available
- Counseling available in Spanish
- Must be age 14 years or older; no parent or guardian necessary

Narcan, a drug used to aid those who have overdosed
