Re: Decision of FIPPA Request 2019-009 (our file number)

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with a decision further to your access to information request made pursuant to the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* ("FIPPA" or "the Act") of Ontario.

Your request, which was officially received by Laurentian University of Sudbury ("the University") on June 3, 2019, was for access to the following records:

"Requesting copies of all correspondence to/from Laurentian University and owner(s) of properties situated at 1825 (the --Trottier" property) and 1863 (the "Art Roy" / "Angie Leblanc" property) South Bay Road, or their representative(s), between January 1, 2018 and May 28, 2019 regarding land, property, or encroachments".

A coordinated search for responsive records was conducted by the following: Office of the Associate Vice-President, Facility Services; the Office of the Vice-President, Administration; the Office of the President and Vice-Chancellor; and the Office of the University Secretary and General Counsel. No responsive records were located.
