- HOW?** Bring shelf-stable food to the north side of the church building, outside Marian Hall. Please remain in your vehicle; volunteers will transfer your donation into pantry carts, to minimize person-to-person contact.
- WHY?** Our pantry shelves empty quickly as we work to meet the increased needs of our community during the health crisis. Several major food drives were cancelled in 2020, forcing us to purchase many of the non-perishable items we distribute.

St. Mary Parish Pantry is grateful for the volunteer assistance provided by *American Heritage Girls*. Typically, AHG organizes a food drive at King Soopers twice per year in support of our ministry, which is not possible at this time.
