- All deposits and tuition are fully refundable until March 31st.
- After April 1st deposits are no longer refundable.
- After June 1st deposits and tuition are non-refundable.
Deposit and tuition payments may be transferred to a new session in the current season if available.
- Within two weeks of the session start date deposits and tuition monies are not refundable or transferable.
- Cancellation due to injury/illness (with a physician's note) can be rolled over to another session for the current season or for the next year.

Riding groups will be separated, and the riding instructor will be responsible for your daughter during that time. You will be able to go on your trail ride together.

We will assign cabins based on your requests. We will do our best to accommodate your requests. All ages may be mixed in the same bunkhouses.
