

*2. Is Badger Care or Public Assistance accepted?*

Currently Dr. Bannasch accepts these payment plans and so do some of the other members of the provider team.

*3. Is a referral for an appointment necessary for Tricare insurance?*

Tricare insurance may require clients to obtain a referral from a primary care physician prior to making an appointment with GJB Health Services. GJB Health Services staff can help to expedite this process and Dr. Bannasch is willing to sign off as a “supervising physician”; if clients have difficulty obtaining a supervising physician on their own.

*4. Is a doctor’s referral necessary to make an appointment?*

Most insurance companies DO NOT REQUIRE a doctor’s referral for the first session.

*5. Do visits have to be pre-certified?*

When the support team calls the insurance provider to obtain co-payment, co-insurance and deductible information, pre-certification information is also requested. Clients should also check with their companies to be absolutely sure that everything is in order, as occasionally, we receive inaccurate information.
